ENROLMENT SCHEME
AS OF JAN 1ST 2010

Pukekohe East School Board of Trustees has approved the Ministry of Education's amendments to the existing Enrolment Zone. All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school:

Starting at the intersection of Kincora Lane and 723 Runciman Road (included) the zone travels south, including Dorsyd Way. The zone turns east into Coulston Road and then into Kern Road (including Patrick Lane). At the Ngakaroa Stream (74 Kern Road) the zone turns around and retraces back to Runciman Road and continues south to meet Pukekohe East Road.

Travelling east (including all of Morgan Road) it then turns south down Harrisville Road and into Jericho Road, including all of Ruebe Road. The zone then moves north at 454 Harrisville Road, turns west along Logan Road and continues north along Golding Road (including Royal Doulton Drive) to Pukekohe East Road. It then moves east along the centre of Pukekohe East Road as far as number 81 (included).

The zone then travels north across country (in accordance with the zoning changes outlined in the Pukekohe North East Structure plan) to rejoin Runciman Road. Continuing north to, and including 331 Tuhimata Road, and including all of Bush Road, and retracing back to the starting point.
