



Pukekohe East School Uniform Procedures

Introduction:

Pukekohe East School Board of Trustees wishes to have a uniform as we believe children wearing the Pukekohe East School uniform will promote a positive image and school identity within our community. The Board of Trustees has endeavoured to ensure the uniform is attractive, hardwearing, practical and affordable.

Purpose:

Wearing a school uniform provides a number of benefits to the school, parents and other stakeholders associated with Pukekohe East School. A uniform ensures that suitable clothing is standardised and appropriate for school activities. Wearing the Pukekohe East School uniform will make Pukekohe East School pupils easily identifiable within the community, therefore enhancing personal safety while traveling to and from school, and on "out of school" activities. Wearing a uniform will enhance school pride, and will remove competition in dress standards. The wearing of a school uniform will also assist with the identification of visitors to the school.

Uniform:

- Navy and teal shirt with School monogram
- Navy and teal sports shirt with School monogram
- Navy Blue shorts with School monogram
- Navy Blue skirts with School monogram (for the girls) optional
- Navy Blue pants (none elasticised leg)
- Navy Blue polar fleece sweatshirt with school monogram
- Navy Blue polar fleece vest with school monogram (optional)
- Navy Blue slouch hat or brimmed hat (compulsory in Terms 1 & 4) with school monogram

Footwear:

Footwear is a personal choice but should be suitable for the activities undertaken at school. The recommended footwear is dark shoes or sandals with back straps. Tidy sneakers and trainers are also acceptable. Navy or white socks are preferred.

Guidelines:

1. All new enrolments to Pukekohe East School are required to wear the school uniform. All students will be required to wear the Pukekohe East School Uniform before they leave the school on outings and trips. There may be exceptions to this guideline from time to time e.g School Camp. These will be advised where appropriate.
2. All clothing and footwear should be clearly named.
3. The complete uniform i.e top and bottom is to be worn. If an item of uniform clothing cannot be worn that day a note must be brought from home and given to the student's teacher. An alternative clothing item, as close to the uniform colour as possible, should be worn.
